WESTLAKE VILLAGE COMMUNITY FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIPS AVAILABLE

The Westlake Village Community Foundation is currently accepting applications for the 2019 Westlake Village Community Foundation Scholarship program. This year, the Foundation is offering scholarships to graduating senior students who have had significant involvement in either the Music, Art, or the Performing Arts program at their high school or in the community or have contributed to the community through volunteer work or community service. To be eligible, the student must be a resident of the City of Westlake Village and have plans to attend a four-year university, a community college, or arts college in the coming year. The award is intended to help cover expenses related to the student's continuing education.

Interested high school seniors are asked to fill out an application available on the City's website www.wlv.org or by visiting City Hall. The deadline for submitting applications is Monday, May 6, 2019. Applicants must be available for an interview during the week of May 13. All interviews will be arranged ahead of time and after 3:30 pm to accommodate school schedules.

The scholarships will be awarded based on commitment to and demonstrated excellence in Music, Arts or Performing Arts at the students' high school or in the community and/or significant contribution to the community through volunteer work or community service. Additional criteria may include academic achievement, school service, community service, interview, and financial need.

THE WESTLAKE VILLAGE COMMUNITY FOUNDATION is dedicated to promote and provide charitable, cultural and educational activities, programs and services for the benefit of those who live in the City of Westlake Village. We are a California Nonprofit Public Benefit Corporation.

In 2019, the Foundation is offering a general scholarship of up to \$2,500 to graduating high school seniors, who have been involved in either the Music, Art, or the Performing Arts program at their high school or in the community or have contributed to the community through volunteer work or community service. To be eligible, the student must be a resident of the City of Westlake Village and have plans to attend a four-year university, a community college or arts college in the coming year. The award is to help in covering expenses related to the student's continuing education.

An application form, provided by THE WESTLAKE VILLAGE COMMUNITY FOUNDATION, must be completed and submitted by interested seniors. Members of the Foundation will review these applications and interview applicants prior to final selection.

The scholarships will be awarded based on either excellence in Music, Arts or Performing Arts programs at the students' high school or in the community and/or significant contribution to the community through volunteer work or community service. Criteria will include years of involvement and level of accomplishment in music, arts or the performing arts and/or volunteer work and community service. Other factors will include: academic achievement, school service, interview and financial need.
