APPROVAL OF MINUTES	Boardmember Blumenfeld moved to approve the minutes of January 25, 2007 as presented. Boardmember Greenspan seconded the motion which passed unanimously.

BUSINESS	<p><u>Update on 2007 TGIF Series</u></p> <p>Staff informed the Board that planning for the TGIF 2007 series is currently underway according to the schedule recommended by the Advisory Board at it's meeting on January 25. The only exception to this was the proposed Comedy Sports night on May 11. Staff was informed by the Comedy Sports group at Agoura High School that the group was not available on May 11 and additionally the group is only able to perform at school functions because of a licensing agreement with Comedy Sports nationally. The Board suggested that staff contact the administration at Agoura High School to assist in pursuing a Comedy Sports night. Additionally, the Board recommended that if Comedy Sports could not be scheduled this year that the City forgo the May 11 TGIF event.</p> <p><u>Discussion of Youth, Citizen, and Older American of the Year</u></p> <p>The Board discussed the nominees for the Youth and Citizen of the</p>

Year Recognition Programs. The Board is recommending that Sue Klamert receive the Citizen of the Year award and that Ayla Nejad receive the Youth of the Year award. Additionally the Board requested the opportunity to re-evaluate the Youth and Citizen of the Year program in an attempt to garner more interest in the program. No names were provided by the Board at the meeting. Staff discussed the annual Los Angeles County Older American of the Year program and solicited nominees for this program from the Board.

Discussion on selection of Teen Member of Advisory Board

Staff informed the Board that the City received seven applications for a teen representative to the Advisory Board. Boardmembers Blumenfeld and Perelman-Taylor agreed to sit on an ad-hoc committee to interview each candidate and make a recommendation to the Cultural Recreation Committee for eventual appointment of the Teen Representative by the full City Council.

Update on 2007 Park Improvement Program

Staff informed the Board that the City Council had approved the recommended improvements to Berniece Bennett, Russell Ranch and Three Springs Parks and that the second park workshop with the Canyon Oaks Home Owners Association is scheduled to be held on Tuesday, March 6 at City Hall.
