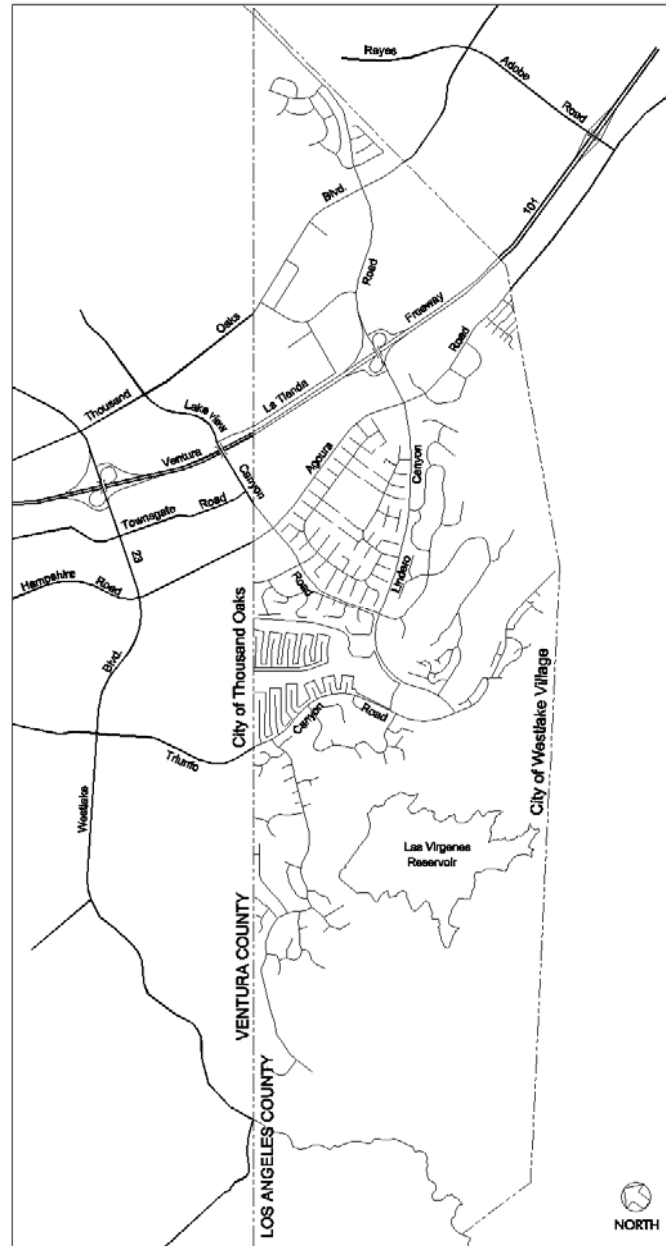


PROP A FUNDS

In November, 1980, the voters of Los Angeles County approved Proposition A, which increased the sales tax 1/2¢ to fund public transportation in the County. A portion of this revenue is returned to cities to be used for public transit purposes. The City of Westlake Village uses these funds to provide the Teen Recreation Dial-A-Ride Service.

ELIGIBILITY

The Teen Recreation Dial-A-Ride service is available to middle and high school aged residents of the City of Westlake Village (Los Angeles County portion of Westlake Village only).

HOW IT WORKS

Riders call MV Transportation at 707-2900 for service. Allow up to 30 minutes for pick-up. Tell the driver that you are participating in the Westlake Village Teen Recreation Dial-A-Ride Service. Indicate your current location and where you would like to be taken.

SERVICE AREA

All rides must originate or terminate at a before or after school enrichment activity. Teens may also use the service for rides to the Westlake Village Library, Agoura Hills Recreation Center, Agoura Hills Calabasas Community Center, YMCA Activities, Thousand Oaks Teen Center and off hours school activities.

Teens may not use the service for rides to and from school.

FARES

Cost to the rider is \$1.00 per one-way trip.
